- Only change to student trip is that students will be going to Wicklow Mountains and not Belfast
- No changes to price at this time
- Flight groups have changed to 4 flight groups
 - 2 groups leave Minneapolis and fly to Newark, where both groups are on the same flight to Dublin
 - 2 groups leave Minneapolis and fly to Philadelphia where both groups are on the same flight to Dublin
- Students are bussed to the airport from the high school on departure day
- Students must find their way home from the airport on return day
- Money from student accounts can be used
 - Contact Nancy Whipple if you need know how much is in the account

 - Can subtract out the amount in the student account
 - Include note (or post it note on check) indicating amount from student account that should be used

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Passports

- Get done now
- Expedite processing
- Note that they seem to be getting very picky on photos

Chaperones

- Responsible for 2 rooms of 3 students (6 students total)
- Meet at high school do introductions, double check they have everything
- Chaperone lists are being finalized this week
 - Includes flight groups

Instruments and Luggage

- Students bring instruments with them
 - Cannot ship instruments due to concert two days before departure
- Instruments may go on different flights from students depending on instrument and airline fees
- Students can bring a backpack and their instrument as carry-on
- Students can have one checked bag
- Checked bag should not exceed 50 pounds
 - Consider having scales at the high school and move around items as needed

Uniforms

- Still looking into shipping, but will depend on cost
- Prepare to have to pack the uniform
- Uniforms will be redistributed prior to the trip
 - Students who had uniforms in past most likely will get the same one
 - Students who haven't had one before, will need to be fitted
 - Dates and times will be announced

Schoolwork

- Trip happens at the end of third quarter
- Students will need to talk to each teacher
 - Get what work they can ahead of time
- Conferences happen before the trip, can talk to teachers at conferences
 - Parents can also email teachers
- Teachers should work with students
- Teachers have until the first week after Spring Break to get grades submitted

Q: How will students get to the airport?

A: Will meet at the high school and will be bussed to the airport. Students will meet chaperones, double-check luggage

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Q: Can students be dropped off directly at the airport?

A: This is a possibility, but only in limited situations. Prefer students be dropped off at high school, if at all possible

Q: Can students be dropped off at the same time they are normally dropped off at school A: Yes, for the rest of the school, it is a normal school day, so students can be dropped off at the same time they normally are dropped off

Q: Can students leave cars at school

A: Most likely, yes. Will have a designated place (most likely in back of teacher's lot)

Q: Can students be taken on side trips for a few hours with parents A: Yes, let Chad Bieniek know. Most likely a hand off from Chad Bieniek and chaperone to the parents

Q: What about students that walk to school

A: Will likely need other arrangements, but can be dropped off at normal school hours

Q: Will there be rehearsals for the parade?

A: Details on rehearsals are coming
